If you are interested in becoming a Vessel Safety Examiner, you can also contact Charlie Virga for information on what to do to receive your Vessel Safety Examiner Certification. Remember, the more Examiners there are, the more boats are examined, the safer our waters.

Captree has 70 members, but we only see about one third of them. Where are you? Each year you faithfully pay your dues, so we know that Captree Power Squadron is important to you. What are we missing; what do we need to do to entice you to become active again? These are the questions that Bridge members constantly ask. Captree is your squadron; I look forward to hearing from you with your suggestions and needs.

I regret missing the May General Membership meeting at which I had planned to distribute AP Certificates to recent grads and solicit your input on elective classes of interest in the future. I had a surgical procedure on my hand the Monday before the meeting and was still feeling a bit under the weather. Speaking of seminars, I hope there will be some interest in *Cruising and Cruise Planning* in the late Fall of 2019 and *Weather* in the Spring of 2020, wow – 2020 already! In addition, I have been advised that District 3 will be teaching a *Junior Navigation (JN)* class this Fall. I really enjoyed the *JN* class when I took it several years ago and plan to proctor and assist at some of the classes. I encourage Captree's AP students to give the *JN* class a try. As I write this, I do not have specifics on the dates and times for the *JN* class.

We have tentatively scheduled an **ABC** class for Saturday, October 26. The class will be in an 8-hour format. On a related subject, there is a possibility that NY State may mandate the requirement to complete a basic boating class for all boaters (**ABC** or equivalent). During the period from May 1, 2018 to April 30, 2019, Captree taught three **ABC** classes to a total of 15 students. We also taught the **Anchoring** seminar to 10 students and **Advanced Piloting** to 6. Good job, Captree! Thank you, students, and most important, our instructors.






