## Lt/C George Tracy, SN Squadron Educational Officer



All is well at the Education Department.

We will be offering an 8-hour **ABC** class on Saturday, October 26 at the Babylon Pool Building at 151 Phelps Avenue, North Babylon. Registration is at 8:30 AM, followed by 8 hours of classroom instruction and a final exam from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Please do all you can to publicize this course.

Captree also plans to offer **CRUISING AND CRUISE PLANNING** beginning on Thursday, October 17. The class will meet for six Thursdays, (10/17, 10/24, 11/14, 11/21, 12/5, and 12/12) from 7:00 to 9:00 PM. I will be hosting the class at my home around the dining room table. The course has been updated relatively recently and is now divided into two parts.

The first part is a traditional series of chapter topics that will be covered as follows:

10/17 - chapters 1 thru 4: Cruise Preparation and Planning – General, Boat, Equipment, Anchors and Anchoring;

10/24 - chapters 5 thru 8: Navigation, Crew, Meals and Provisions, Communications; and

11/14 - chapters 9 thru 13: Foreign waters, Chartering, Security, Emergencies and Medical, Weather.

The second part of the course encompasses four specific cruises:

11/21 Intracoastal Waterway and the Great Lakes; and

12/5 Inland Rivers and the Pacific Northwest.

On 12/12, a review will be conducted followed by a final exam.

I will be lead instructor for the class. Fortunately, we have Captree members who are experts in many of these subject areas and have cruised in these locations. I will be calling on you to help out. I will need to know who will be taking the class no later than our September 18 General Membership meeting so I can order the books. Cost is \$50 for members and \$100 for non-USPS members. If you want to volunteer to teach a specific area, please contact me, otherwise, I will be seeking you out. You know who you are. Everyone, even those not taking the course, are encouraged to stop by. Class will be somewhat informal. This is a fun class!
